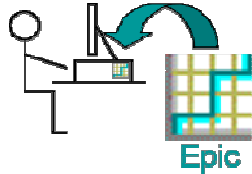


Incremental Epic Fact Sheet

Installing Epic

This fact sheet discusses how you might deploy Incremental Epic within your yard. It illustrates four types of deployment, reflecting four different scenarios. In real-life the exact deployment would depend on your choice of functionality and the level integration with existing systems.

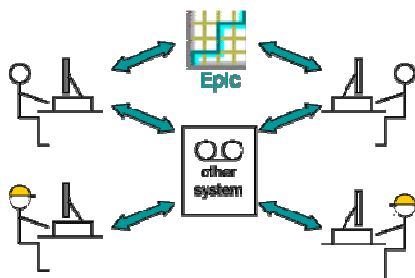
Standalone



Incremental Epic runs on a single computer. Suitable for:

- small yards where all administration and management is carried out by a single person;
- running repairs where a laptop can be taken on board.

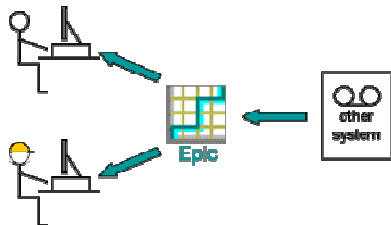
Dedicated Function



Incremental Epic used for specific functions. Generated data exported to a other systems:

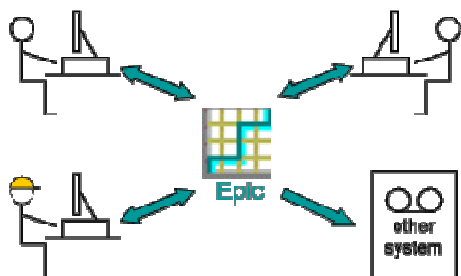
- during gradual adoption of Epic;
- for staff dedicated to a single function such as estimators or a 'time office' function.

Reporting



Incremental Epic extracts and reports information from existing systems. Suitable where the yard has existing systems that it does not want to change but wants the productivity of Epic's intuitive and focused interface.

Primary Source



What we recommend!

Incremental Epic is the primary source for management data. Its specialised interfaces are used for entering data, reading information and exporting either to other systems or directly to paper.
